Please find enclosed applications for barley, oats and wheat trials. Barley will be tested at 2 locations (Lenoir, Rowan); Oats will be tested at 3 locations (Beaufort, Lenoir, Rowan); wheat will be tested at 5 locations (Beaufort, Lenoir, Perquimans, Robeson, Rowan).

If you treat the seed with a systemic fungicide or insecticide such as Baytan, Cruiser, Gaucho, etc. you must enter the same variety without this special seed treatment at your expense. If you treat the seed of any entry with these seed treatments and it was not treated that way in the past, you will not have multi year averages.

Please adhere to the deadlines established so that we may plant the tests on time. Thanks for your cooperation and sponsorship.

You must enter at all locations.

**Disclaimer:**

Seed received for testing will be used solely for that purpose. North Carolina State University will not isolate or have isolated, sequence or have sequenced, or analyze or have analyzed genetic material from seed received, and shall not use any biotechnology processes to manipulate the seed. Seed received will not be transferred to a third party. North Carolina State University agrees not to use the seed of any experimental lines for plant breeding or seed stock increases. North Carolina State University retains the right to make crosses with commercially released, non-transgenic, non-patented varieties.

NOTE: There will be a barley OVT only if we receive a sufficient number of entries.
